FACTS AND FIGURES

Last year's season started out slow and ended quickly. The DOT traffic counter was set up last season on Trail C5 across from the groomer barn. It recorded 10,272 sleds in January, 8,524 in February and 3,203 in March. In order to keep the trails as smooth as possible, last season the club logged 576 grooming hours, traveled 3,272 miles and used approximately 2,831 gallons of fuel to groom our 42 miles of trails.

PATRON PROJECT:

In April all members received a letter explaining the Patron Project. Thank you to the members who have already donated and getting this project off the ground. Any donations, no matter how big or small, will be greatly appreciated, and go directly to towards the new groomer barn.

GROOMER BARN BUILDING UPDATE:

We are currently working with an architect to finalize building plans. Once complete, we will be getting new and updated quotes to finalize the budget. Our plan is to begin construction in Spring of 2023. Between now and then we will continue to work on fundraising and possible grant opportunities.
