GROOMER BARN BUILD UPDATE-Members are asking what's happening on the new Groomer Barn build. We don't blame you for asking and being curious. We went thru a lot of paperwork, town board, engineers, surveyor, and architect which took a lot longer than anticipated. We then received bids for an 80' x 60' stick building which ended up being very expensive. We are now working with our engineer and changing plans to a pole barn building. It will happen and we are sorry that it's taken so long. We will continue to raise funding for our new facility and thank all who graciously donated to our Patron Building Fund.

GRANT

Ken & Gerry Burd along with Bill Brasser and Dominic Siracusa applied for an ARPA grant which was handled thru Oswego County. After going through several committees and also with the County Legislature, we were awarded \$70,000, which is designated for overhead doors, septic system and the well for the new groomer barn.
